### Course Description

The compulsory History of Quebec and Canada course is designed to promote greater understanding of the many social, ethnic, religious, economic, linguistic, and cultural facets that have shaped Quebec within its Canadian context.

Students will gain not only a greater understanding of the past, and how it is written, but also how our history shapes our present society, and our role within it. To this end, students will cover the course thematically, rather than chronologically. The History of Quebec and Canada is a required Ministry of Education (MELS) course. The MELS sets out the curriculum. The MELS makes up the June provincial exam. Students must pass the course to graduate.
