Regular Dress Code (October 1 - April 30)

*Secondary 1, 2, 3, 4 students must wear items from the 2016 to 2018 collections or the new 2019-2020 collection.
Only Secondary 5 students may wear the St. Andrew's kilt.*

TOPS	BOTTOMS
<p>One of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Short sleeve polo ● Long sleeve polo ● Dress shirt <p>* Tops must be tucked into kilt or pants ** School tie (optional)</p> <p>One of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● School sweater ● School cardigan ● School blazer <p>* Between October 1 and April 30, students MUST wear the sweater, cardigan or blazer over their polo or shirt.</p>	<p>One of the following combinations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Grey pants neatly pressed and hemmed ● Black or navy belt (mandatory) ● Regulation school socks (blue or grey) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ No sport socks or ankle socks ● Kilt (two inches above the knee maximum) ● Navy blue or grey opaque tights <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ No nylons <p>* All combinations require the wearing of regulation school shoes (purchased from supplier only)</p>

Summer Dress Code (May 1 - September 30)

Miscellaneous Uniform Items

<p>Villa Maria Physical Education Uniform</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Cross-Training multi-sport running shoes with non-marking soles and white socks ● Regulation gym T-shirt, shorts or track pants (purchased from supplier) ● Villa Maria hoodie 	<p>Lab Coat & Safety Glasses</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Mandatory for all classes held in the laboratories.
<p>Pedagogical Day & After-School Attire</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students present in school for any reason on a Pedagogical Day, immediately after school or at an availability period must be in full school uniform. 	<p>Personal Grooming and presentation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Hair: dyed natural color, no extravagant hairstyle, no hair in front of the eyes. ● Clean shaven. ● Discreet and simple jewellery. ● Nail polish, acrylic/gel, etc are allowed. However, nail length must be safe for lab and Phys. Ed. activities, subject to the discretion of school staff. ● Pants: worn above the hips and the hem and waistband unrolled. ● Skirt: worn unrolled and hemmed. ● Uniform must be kept clean and mended at all times.

UNIFORM DRESS CODE

- Hair: dyed natural color, no extravagant hairstyle, no hair in front of the eyes
- Clean shaven

Between October 1st and April 30th, wear one of the following:
Navy blue school sweater, cardigan or jacket (girls and boys)

Kilt (two inches above the knee maximum)

Between October 1st and April 30th, wear the navy blue or grey opaque tights (no nylons)

Navy blue or grey regulation knee socks
Must be pulled up (May 1st - September 30th)

Polo or dress shirt
Must be tucked into pants

Grey pants neatly pressed with black or navy belt (obligatory)

Regulation school socks (blue or grey)
No sport socks or ankle socks

Regulation school shoes (purchased from supplier only)
